JUMP! TEACHING PHILOSOPHY

We understand that children are busy and will need encouragement to want to continue their language fluency. E.L.S.A. provides practical use of the language where children will continue to see the value of what they are learning. Through projects, community interaction, E.L.S.A. trips, presentations, public speaking and relationship building, children will want to come to school and be a part of this unique opportunity.

TUITION STRUCTURE

- ▶ **Yearly Tuition:** Down Payment of \$200 with payment of \$4,234 due by June 1st.
- ▶ **Monthly Tuition:** Down Payment of \$200 followed by payments of \$485 per month for 9 months.

REQUIREMENTS

Attendance: Children whom attend this program must attend twice per week and Saturday morning or two times per week and one computer conference class. They must also participate in Jump and local community events. Calendar will be given to families for the year in early August.

E.L.S.A. will run on a 9 months schedule as consistency is required for success. Consistency requires a year-long commitment from September 23, 2019 - June 5, 2020.

Fluency: Children whom attend this program must have completed at least Kindergarten in an immersion school or be tested into the program.
